CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS

Cuckmere Valley Canoe Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Pat Cox – Welfare Officer.

As a member of *Cuckmere Valley Canoe Club* you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- All members must participate within the club rules and regulations and safety policy
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Junior members should show abide by all safety instructions given by the coach supervising their group.
- Members must wear suitable kit – Buoyancy Aid and helmet when deemed necessary by the club coach supervising the group.
- Members must pay any fees for courses before starting on the course.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises including the clubhouse and adjacent car park.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises.
