CODE OF PRACTICE FOR PARENTS/ CARERS

- Encourage your child to read and understand the club rules as set out in the club membership booklet 'Little Blue' and to paddle within the rules.
- Ensure that you read and understand the club rules, safety and welfare policies as available in the club membership book.
- Discourage unfair behaviour and arguing with club coaches and other volunteers.
- Help your child to recognise good performance and team working on and off the water, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances and team work from all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for making mistakes or learning new skills at their own speed.
- Publicly accept and support coach and club volunteer decisions and judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their chosen sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times whilst on club trips, events and whilst in or close to club facilities
- Encourage and guide your child to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and development,
- Ensure that your child adheres to all manual handling practices including safe lifting, carrying and storage of kayaks and canoes
